The League is nonpartisan. We do not support or oppose any political party or candidate. The League focuses on policies, encouraging participation of citizens in government, and influencing public policy through education and advocacy. Membership is open to all.

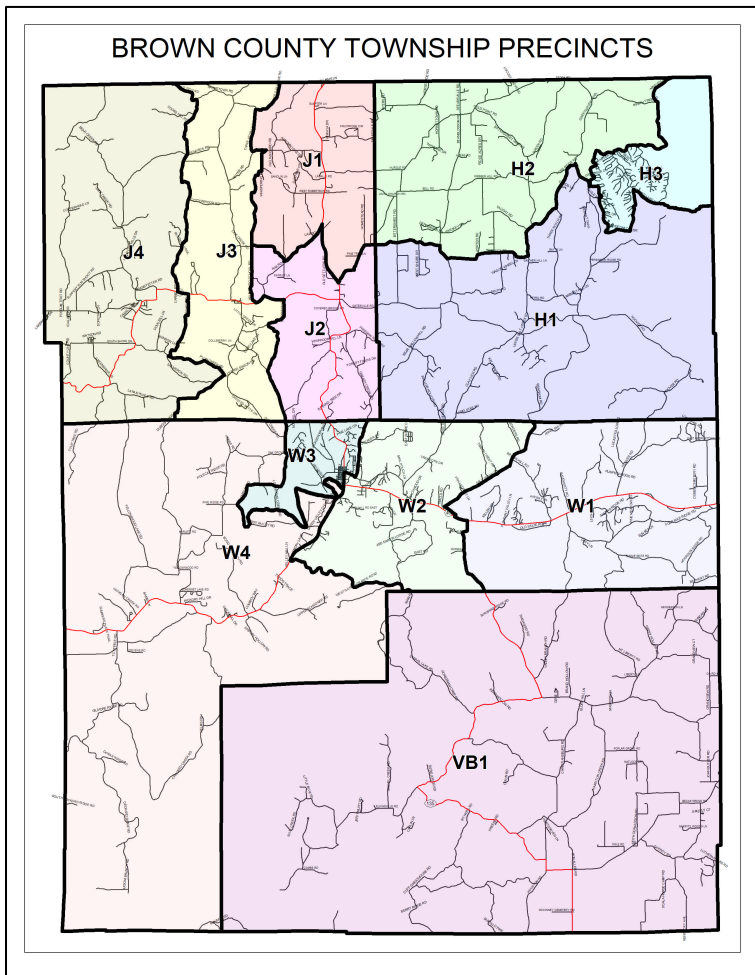

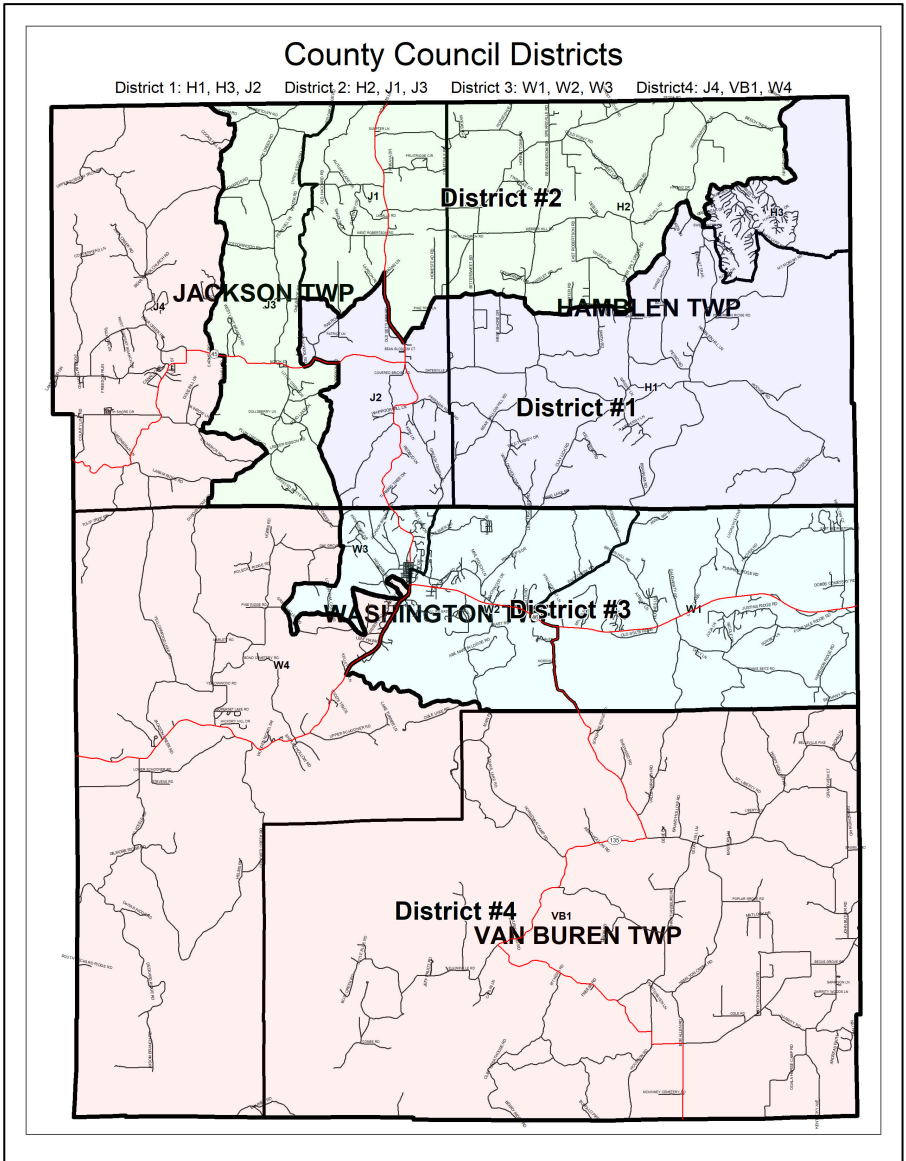

BROWN COUNTY TOWNSHIP PRECINCTS MAP

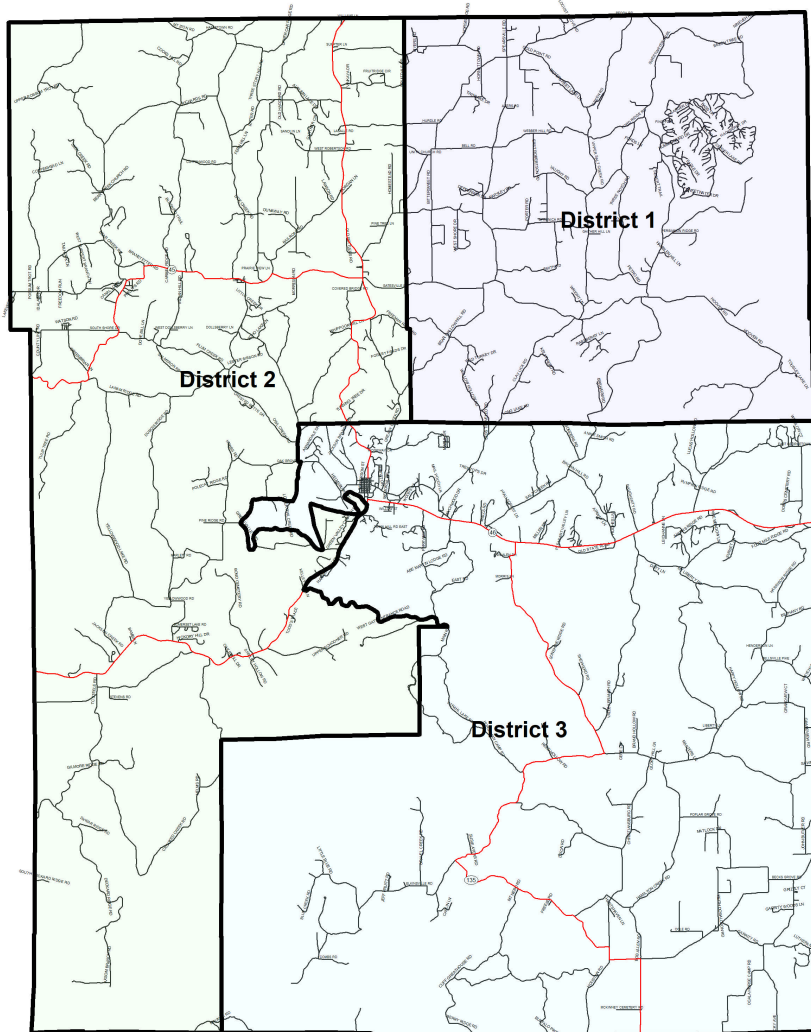


BROWN COUNTY COUNCIL DISTRICTS MAP

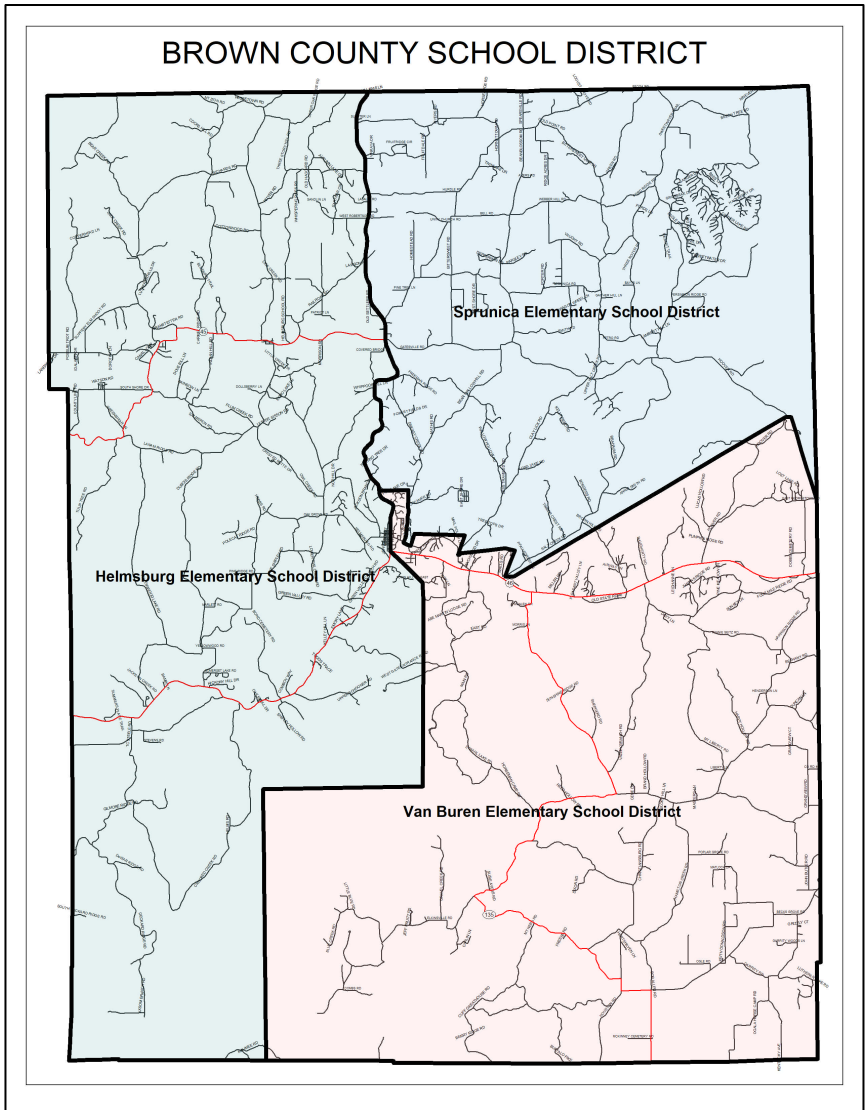


BROWN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS DISTRICTS MAP

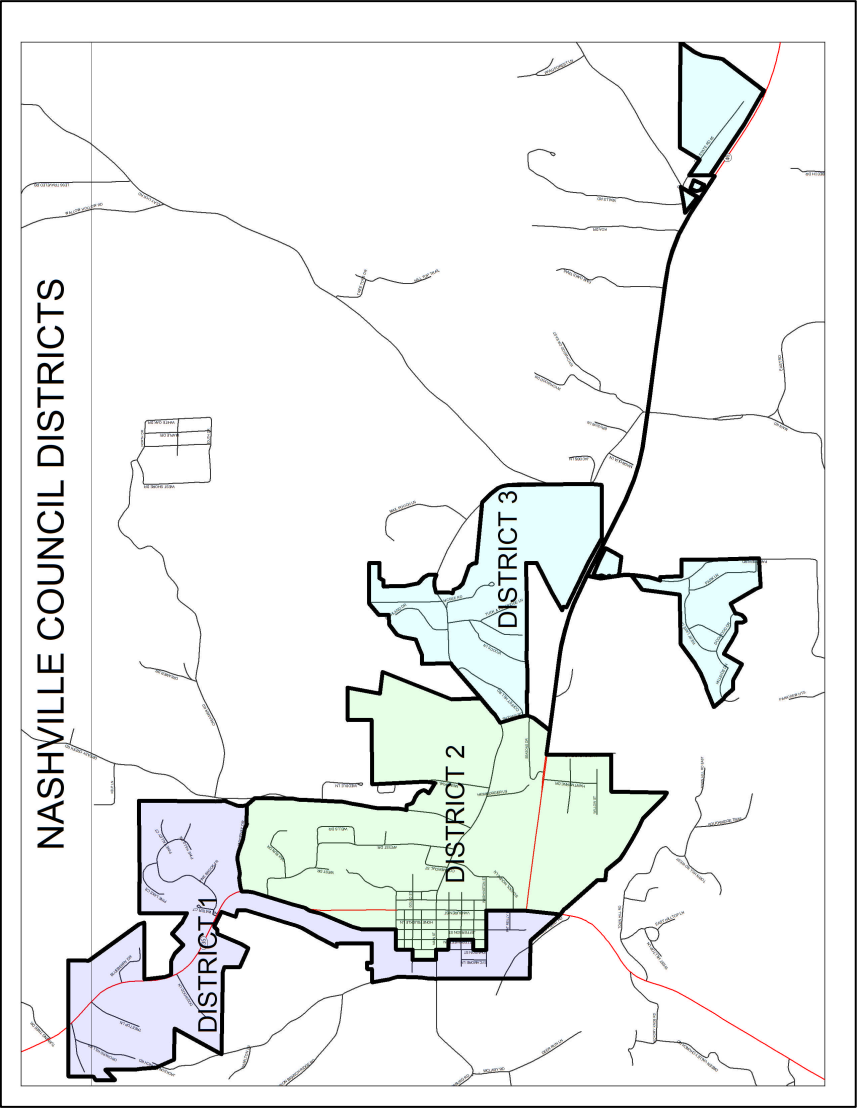
County Commissioners Districts
