You have the right to vote in Indiana if: You are a U.S. citizen and resident of Indiana; AND You are at least 18 years old on or before the election; AND You are not currently in prison, convicted of a crime; AND You've lived in your voting precinct at least 30 days before the election; AND

You are registered to vote (before the deadline).

Register to vote BY DEADLINE one month before the primary or general election: Register online at indianavoters.com; OR

Call 1-866-IN-1-VOTE (1-866-461-8683) with the Indiana Secretary of State's office; OR

Register in person at the Brown County Clerk's Office in the courthouse; OR Register at the Bureau of Motor Vehicles (BMV) if conducting a transaction such as getting a driver's license, permit or identification card.
